Expectations for I/WE Student Award Recipients:

- Participate in at least one I/WE signature event in the year of your award. I/WE signature events take place in the fall and spring semesters (typically one event per semester).
- Provide a short written statement sharing how the I/WE Student Award is helping you to achieve your goals. Your statement may appear in Elliott School publications and media outlets, such as newsletters, brochures, websites, and social media.
