Important Information: General elective courses are courses that do not satisfy specific requirements. Electives are taken in addition to the courses used to satisfy requirements to earn 120 credits (required to graduate). At least 60 credits must be earned in-residence at GW. A 2.0 cumulative GPA is required to graduate. General Education courses can share with Elliott Intro and Major courses; Elliott Intro and Major courses cannot double count between each other.
