Comprehensive Action Plan (CAP)

- Consists of two parts:
 - Plan of Study (academic planning component)
 - Professional Interest
 Questions (career planning component)
- Provides academic and career goal context for your program director, academic advisor & career coach.

What is a Comprehensive Action Plan (CAP)?

Required for all Elliott students during their first semester.

Your Plan of Study is:

- A visual representation of your intentions to complete the requirements for your program.
- A planning tool that will assist you in mapping out your courses while at the Elliott School.
- An auditing tool that will assist you and your Advisor with any necessary updates to DegreeMAP.
- The Plan of Study is NOT a binding agreement. Changes can be made due to interests becoming more refined and as course offerings change.

The professional interest questions are:

- A quick representation of your *current* career development interests.
- A tool your Career Coach and advisors will use to provide additional advice and guidance, as well as guide GSS programming and partnerships.

They are **NOT**:

 An in-depth plan - you are strongly encouraged to schedule an appointment with your career coach in order to create a personalized Professional Development plan.

Completing the Plan of Study

All sections of the plan of study are required.

Filling out each section:

- Include the course number ex: IAFF 6118
- List the course title which can be found in the GW Bulletin.
 - Please do not list *Special Topics in...* as there are many classes under that category.
- Include the credit value of the course.
- Indicate the semester and year you plan to take a class ex: *Fall 2022* or *Fa22*.
 - We understand this may change and adjustments can be made to your CAP.
- Comment section: this is for you to add any notes you wish for your program director or advisor to know.
- Make sure you enter your total credits, and if you exceed the required credits, explain your reasoning in the comments section

- Once you have completed the POS, return to the Forms and Applications page.
- Select the accordion labeled Comprehensive Action Plan Submission Click on your program, and the webform will launch.

Upon submission, the information will be reviewed by your program director, academic advisor, and career coach.

Next Steps: Submitting the CAP

- Once you follow the above steps, the CAP will be sent to your program director and academic advisor. At the end of the process you will receive a copy and it will be saved to your academic record.
- You are *not* required to meet with your academic advisor, please do if you have questions!
- Some programs require that you meet with your Program Director to go over your initial academic plans, but they will contact students directly to schedule (ex. Security Policy Studies).

Beyond the CAP

Interested in exploring your professional goals further? The <u>Career Map tool</u> can help!

• The Career Map is a framework to capture your current career plans, from the dream that brought you to the Elliott School through graduation day and beyond. Use it as a reflection piece to jot down your plans, then bring it in to any <u>career exploration coaching session</u>, so that you'll have a starting point. Don't worry about being perfect; simply put down what you know so far, and we'll help you from there.
