

In April 2015, in response to a request from the Student Association, the Faculty Senate passed a resolution that sought the creation of a system through which faculty could provide students with additional information with which to make better informed decisions about course selection. As the resolution and the discussion of the Faculty Senate stated, students deserve adequate information before selecting their courses, and faculty seek motivated and prepared students for the courses they intend to teach. Furthermore, students wish to know if the courses they are selecting will advance their study within their areas of interest, and faculty teach best to students who have selected courses appropriate to their interests.

The documents available here have been provided by the faculty specifically for this purpose. Any syllabus should be considered an example of how the course might be taught, and is subject to revision prior to the start of the class.




